GRM 2023 Honorariums

GRM participants will receive a symbolic honorarium (for in-person participation) to help defray costs

The honorariums come in three categories:

Delegates coming from anywhere except Europe or UK:

- For 1 author: the author will receive 250 GBP.
- For 2 authors (main author and 1 co-author): the authors will receive a total of 350 GBP.
- For 3 authors (main author and 2 co-authors): the authors will receive a total of 450 GBP.
- For more than three authors: 450 GBP will be divided amongst the authors.

Delegates coming from Europe:

- For 1 author: the author will receive 150 GBP.
- For 2 authors (main author and 1 co-author): the authors will receive a total of 250 GBP.
- For 3 authors (main author and 2 co-authors): the authors will receive a total of 350 GBP.
- For more than three authors: 350 GBP will be divided amongst the authors.

Delegates coming from the UK:

- For 1 author: the author will receive 100 GBP.
- For 2 authors (main author and 1 co-author): the authors will receive a total of 200 GBP.
- For 3 authors (main author and 2 co-authors): the authors will receive a total of 300 GBP.
- For more than three authors: 300 GBP will be divided amongst the authors.

Each participant can receive only one honorarium (even if you co-author more than one paper), and no more than three honorariums will be provided per submitted paper (maximum 3 authors). If a paper has more than 3 authors, then the authors can arrange amongst themselves how to divide the 3 honorariums.

The honorariums will not be paid in advance, and missing a portion of the workshop discussion without prior approval could result in the loss of your honorarium. Please let us know your preferred method of receiving the honorarium to be paid to you. This can be done either by bank transfer or in cash in Cambridge. Respecting all deadlines and attending the full meeting are the conditions for receiving the honorarium.
